Volunteer Ministry Description

- Each year, lead at least one Small Group Leader Training seminar at a *Jesus Weekend* or at a local church. (Travel, meals, and lodging expenses paid for.)
- Be regularly leading a *Person of Jesus* study for at least part of the year.
- Monthly meetings with a five-person seeJesus Partner cohort.

Monthly Fellowship and Mentoring

- In addition to our face-to-face meetings at the Jesus Weekend, we'll meet monthly via conference call with Paul Miller and Tim Strawbridge. During this time Paul will lead discussions on Jesus and interactive teaching. We'll begin reading through a scholarly list of books on Jesus.
- We'll also spend time on current ministry issues you may have. In order to discuss an issue, you must put it in writing to Paul ahead of time in writing via email.

Optional Additional Opportunities

- Overseas Jesus Weekends/Weeks. At least three alumni of Small Group Leader Training or the *Person of Jesus* seminar have led *Jesus Weekends/Weeks* overseas where the *Person of Jesus* material was the centerpiece. We are planning on having annual overseas conferences.
- Lead a *Person of Jesus* seminar if the opportunity arises.
- Do a mini-seminar or help run a booth at mission conventions or at a denomination not familiar with *Person of Jesus* material.
- Opportunity to be mentored in development work.

- September, lead a *Small Group Leader Training* at a Jesus Weekend in London (5 days)
